

Botswana Safari



Sample Itinerary

Day One

Overnight flight from London to Johannesburg
There are several major carriers to Johannesburg from London each evening

Day Two

On arrival, clear customs and immigration and proceed to the Air Botswana counter for check in to Botswana. The flight is approximately 2 hours to Kasane, the gateway to Chobe National Park. Your guide will meet you and transfer you by road to the lodge that overlooks the Chobe River. After a light snack/tea and coffee you will be going on your first safari expedition into the Chobe National Park. Enjoy a sundowner whilst watching the herds of game coming down to drink.
Dinner under the stars in your lodge.

Chobe National Park is well known for its herds of Elephant and Buffalo as well as predators. This is one of the really big wildlife destinations in Southern Africa.

Day Three

Early morning game drive into the park, returning back to the lodge for a brunch and well deserved siesta. In the afternoon take a boat cruise on the Chobe River and experience a true African sunset. (Option to do an afternoon game drive or perhaps some fishing).

Day Four

After an early morning activity, depart for your light aircraft flight to Linyanti. Your guide will meet you and transfer you to the camp where you will have lunch. After your siesta, explore the Linyanti forests and open plains looking for the rare wild dog and cheetah amongst kudu, impala elephant and other game.
Dinner back at camp, whilst being serenaded by the sounds of an African night.

Day Five

Early morning game drive, perhaps stopping for a short walk. Learn about the animal tracks and plants and their medicinal uses. Brunch and a Siesta followed by an afternoon game drive.

Day Six

Last chance to see the Linyanti area before your flight to the Okavango Delta, There are many different ways to explore the myriad of waterways, but a must should be by Mokoro, a traditional dugout canoe. Silent and relaxing, let your poler glide you through the papyrus, miscanthus and phragmites reed beds searching for painted reed frogs, and the elusive sitatunga antelope. Dinner in camp serenaded by the bell frogs.

Day Seven

Spend the day exploring the islands of the Okavango by motorboat, mokoro or on foot. Perhaps a spot of fishing too!

Day Eight

Morning walk or game drive on the islands looking at the amazing birdlife, followed by a flight to the Makgadikgadi Salt pans. A short drive to your camp on the edge of this amazing landscape. Afternoon game drive in the National Park

Day Nine

Early morning walk spent with the family of habituated meerkats or drive onto the edge of the pans to look for stone age tools. Afternoon exhilaration with a quad bike drive across the salt pans. See the curvature of the earth!

Day Ten

Morning drive to Chapmans Baobabs, the largest Baobab tree in Botswana. Brunch at camp followed by a transfer back to the airstrip for your afternoon flight to Maun to connect with Air Botswana to Johannesburg and your onward flight to London.
